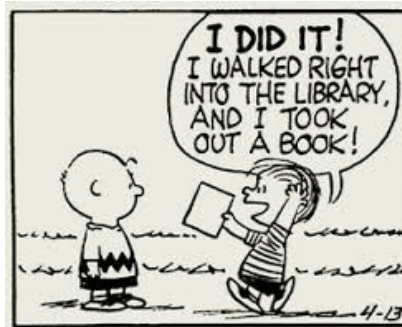
(I'll give you a hint: two teachers = double the ideas, half the assessments, half the work load, half the stress).

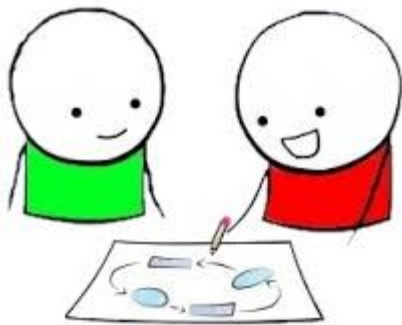
GRADE 7 ORIENTATIONS
